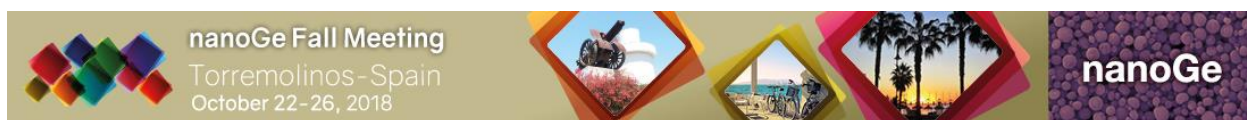

Eternal summer

The constant blue of the sky is reflected in the sea beside Melià Costa del Sol. Enjoy the beach at your feet all year round, a fully-equipped convention centre and hotel on the seafront.

The modern and elegant Convention Centre at the Melià Costa del Sol located in Málaga, in Torremolinos, on the Costa del Sol, and strategically located 10 minutes from the International Airport of Malaga and 15 minutes from the AVE Malaga / Maria Zambrano train station.

HOW TO GET TO

By taxi:

From Malaga Airport: Melià Costa del Sol Convention Centre is 10 minutes away from Malaga Airport.

Price: 25.00€

The airport has a well-signposted taxi rank outside the arrivals area of Terminal T3. Make sure that the taxi driver has started the taximeter at the beginning of the journey (minimum fare). We recommend requesting a receipt for any complaint or claim.

By train:

There is a train station at the Airport.

Line C1. Stop: Torremolinos. The Convention centre is 800m away from the train station in Torremolinos (about 10 min walk).

One way ticket: 1.80€

The first train to Torremolinos leaves the airport at 05:32, leaving every 20-30 minutes until the last train at 23.42

From Ave Station Maria Zambrano (Málaga): Meliá Costa del Sol Convention Centre is located 15 minutes away from the Ave Station.

You can check the timetables on the website of the national rail company RENFE which offers online booking in English [here](#) (please select "Search all stations" and then select Departure point "Aeropuerto" and destination "Torremolinos").

By bus:

You will find the bus stop straight in front of you outside the arrivals area of Terminal T3 on the side of the road where there are a couple of shelters with seats.

You will also see a ticket office in the left-hand corner of the arrivals forecourt where you should purchase your tickets for the journey.

Line: Torremolinos-Benalmadena-Airport.

The single fare for this journey is €3.80.

Estimated travel time: 30 minutes.

Torremolinos is not a big city. The best way to get around in the city is to walk, to take a taxi or the local buses.

INTERNET ACCESS/WIFI

ORAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Standard Audio Visual Package at the conference rooms: LCD projector, screen, laser pointer and wireless microphone.

Presentation Times:

Invited Speakers are scheduled for 30 minutes (25 minutes talk + 5 minutes questions).

Contributed presentations are scheduled for 30 minutes (25 minutes talk+ 5 minutes, questions) and 15 minutes (12 minutes talk + 3 minutes, questions); check your slot at the symposium schedule for timing.

The organization wants to encourage the symposia debates and questions; therefore, it is necessary to strictly respect the time for discussions.

Speaker preparation: The presenters will be able to check the presentation onsite no later than the “break” immediately preceding the session. Break, in this sense, is the period of time before the first-morning talk and during the lunch or coffee break. Please come with sufficient time in advance. Authors must provide to the assistant a USB memory with the presentation or bring their own laptop.

Audio Visual Assistance: There will be assistant if any problem arises in each room.

Advise: Before you start designing your next presentation, make sure you know what size your slides should be for an optimal viewing experience. Check this information in page 9 of this document (Format 16:10 or 4:3).

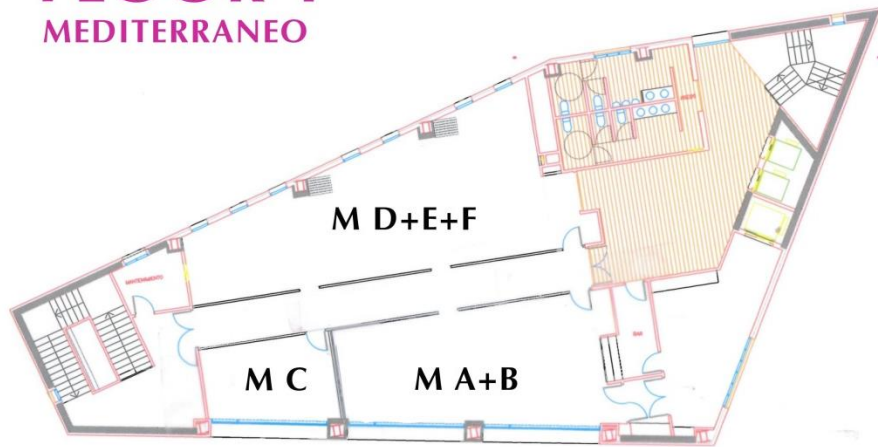
