The aims of the workshop:

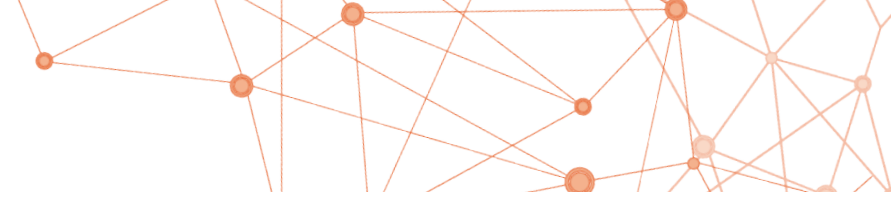
To provide an overview of progress in the field and an opportunity to speak to the researchers:

 - Separate evaluation opportunity (targeted on women and energy)



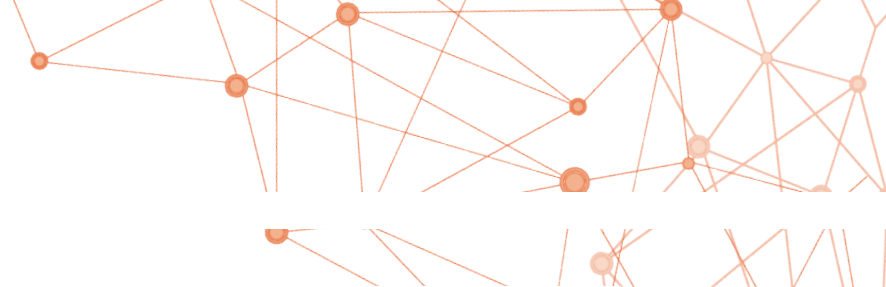
