


Information for exhibitors <u>Monday 12th – Wednesday 14th of June 2023</u>

- On Wednesday, June 14th 2023 from 08:00h to 17:00h.


24 hours before the conference start you will receive a QR code via email. This code will be required at the registration desk.

GROUND FLOOR


