Important information for speakers

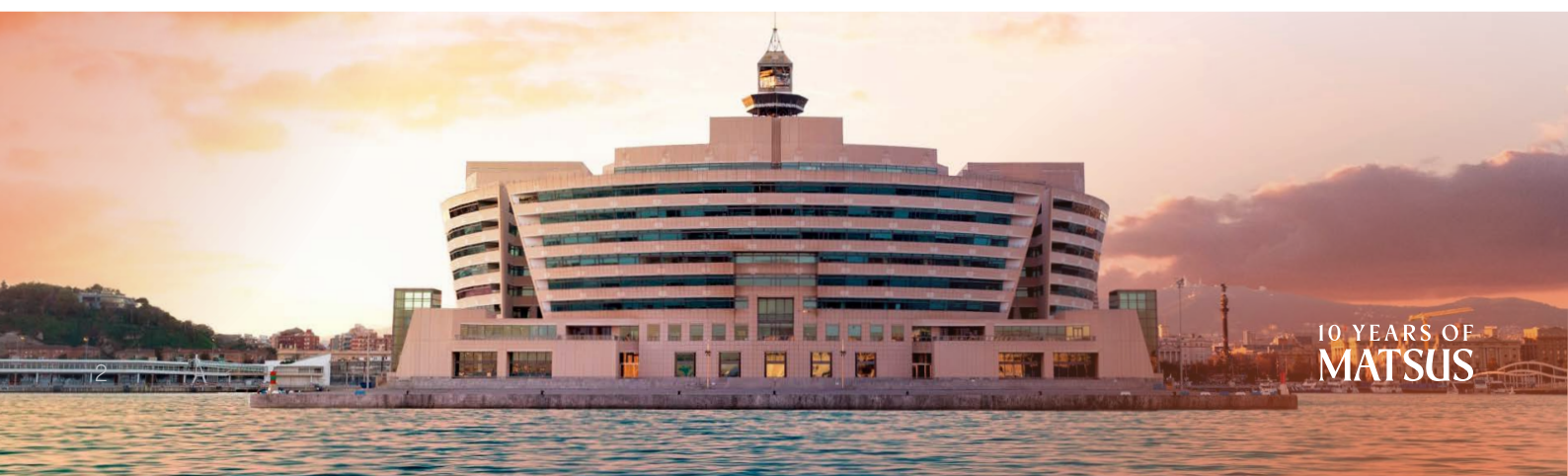

Audio-Visual Package: Computer, LCD projector, screen, laser pointer and microphone.

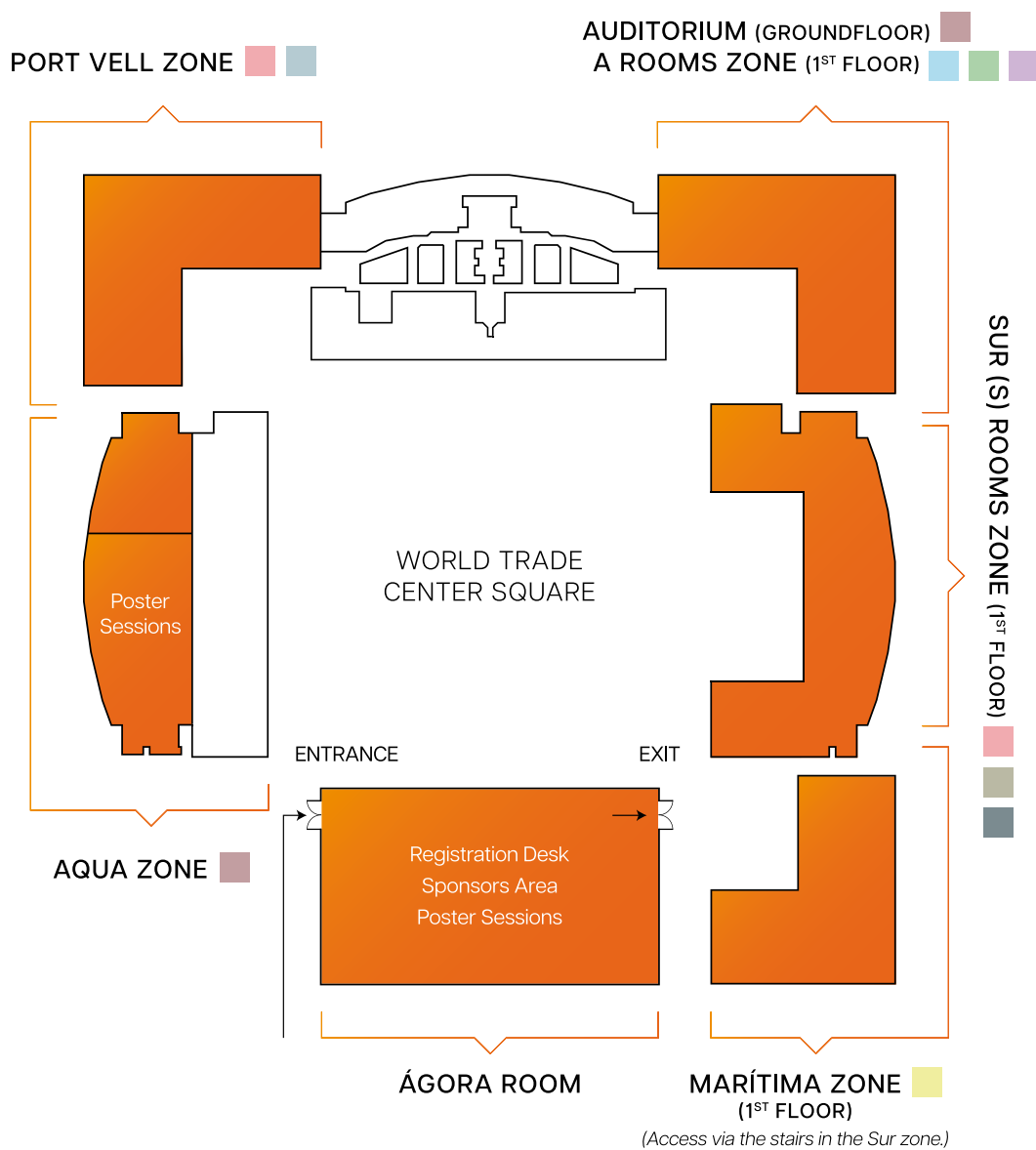
The organization wants to encourage the conference debates and questions. Therefore, it is necessary to strictly respect the time for discussions. The use of personal computers will not be permitted.

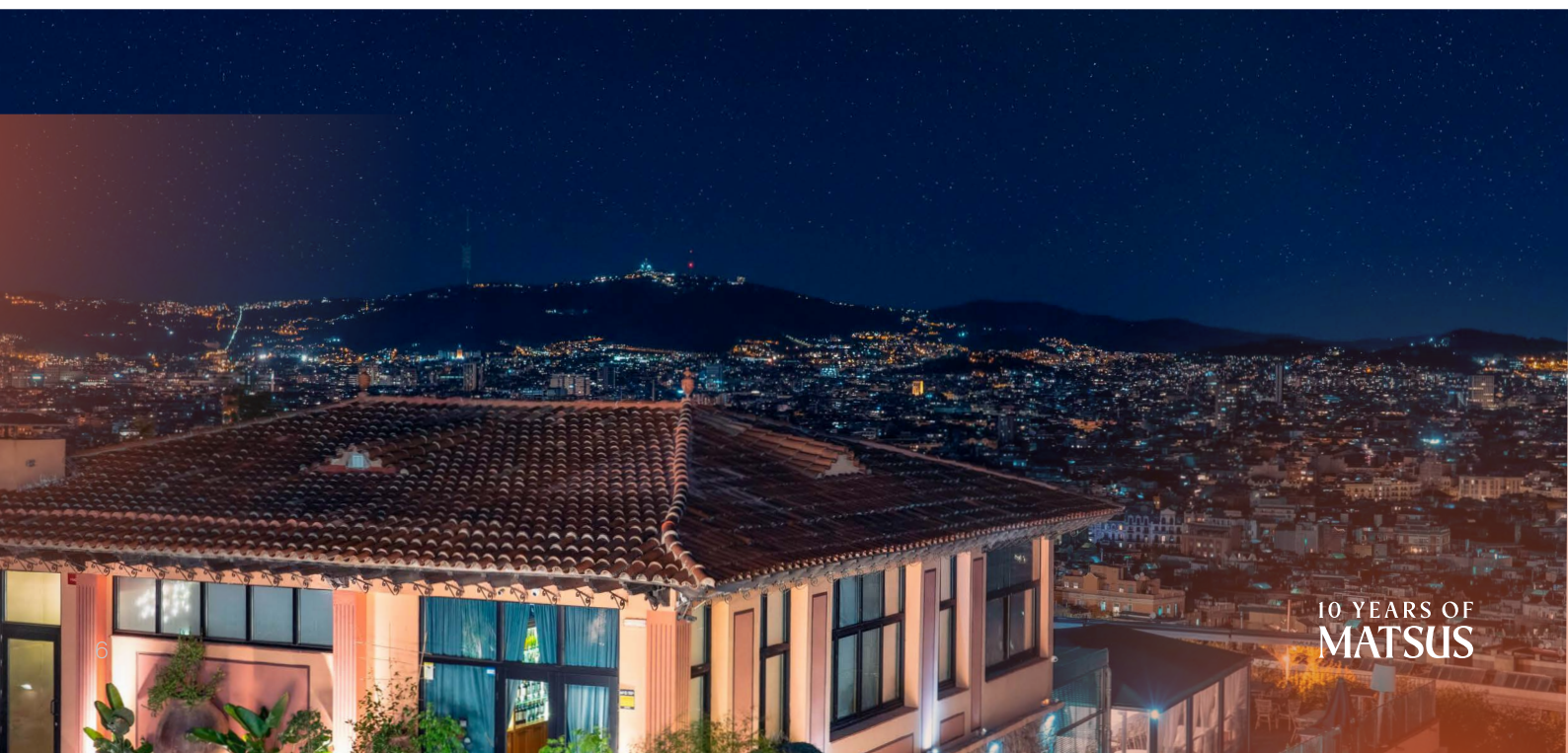
